Dear Parents, We are looking forward to having your children with us at the Summer Camp 2022 at:-

Colin Godman's Farm, Perryman's Lane, Furner's Green, Uckfield, TN22 3RR

Colin Godman's Farm is in the beautiful Ashdown Forest near Forest Row in Sussex and is managed bio-dynamically with sheep and cattle by Jayne and Michael Duveen. It is 3 hrs by car from Stroud. The nearest train station is Haywards Heath (20min). The nearest airport is Gatwick (30min)

The camp begins at 15⁰⁰ on the 23rd July with registration at the farm-yard. Please be punctual!

On arrival at Colin Godman's Farm you must please check your child in and settle any outstanding payments and forms. You are then welcome to have some refreshments before you go. If you need to make contact with us during the camp you can contact one of us on our mobile phones. (**See numbers below**) Mobile phone reception is sporadic on the farm so where possible we would prefer to use texts. We will make a point of going to a place of better reception at least every evening to pick up and respond to messages.

Important!! Please make sure your child is **free of lice** before the camp!

Bring List (Please ensure all are well marked):

- Water bottle
- Sleeping bag, camp mattress & pillow. **Please avoid a blow-up mattress as they take up so much space.** Smaller foam or self-inflating mats are more than adequate.
- Summer play clothing, jersey, anorak, track-suit, pyjamas
- Sun hat & sun cream
- Good walking/hiking shoes and/or boots, sport shoes
- Slip-slops and/or sandals
- Good rain-gear, wellingtons and something extra warm for cold spells.
- Bathing costume and two towels
